Technical partner for new smart communities code announced

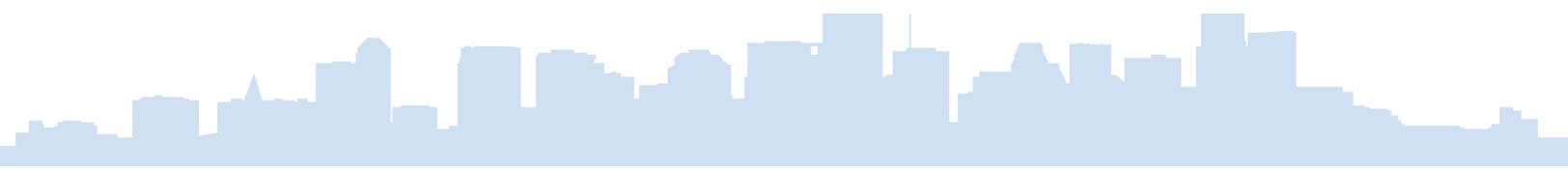
